

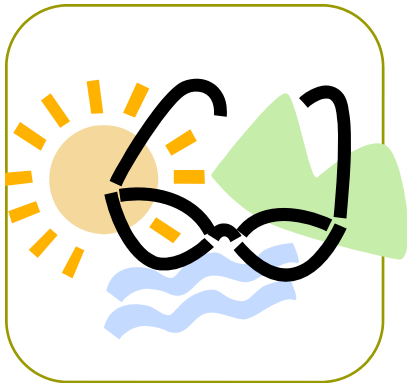

Summer School for High School Students

- Issaquah School District curriculum will be taught using district instructional materials and resources.
- Students with disabilities who, with reasonable accommodations, are able to participate and derive educational benefit in a regular classroom setting using regular curricula are eligible to apply; however special education is not available as part of the regular summer school program.
- ELL services are not available for the summer program, however, ELL students who are able to participate in a regular classroom setting using regular curricula are eligible to apply.
- District grades and attendance procedures will be followed; more than 7 ½ hours (3 periods) of missed classes will result in no credit.

Please note that low enrollment courses may be cancelled.

Registration

- Registration begins March 17, 2008. Summer School Registration forms are available in all Issaquah School District High School Counseling offices or online at www.issaquah.wednet.edu
- Registration forms **must** include counselor, parent, and student signatures. (Counselors may not be available after the last day of school so please plan accordingly.)
- Payment must accompany registration (Checks to: *ISD Summer School*)

Summer School Fees:

- \$280.00 per class for registrations dropped off or postmarked **by** May 5, 2008.
- **Note:** A minimum deposit of \$100.00 is required WITH REGISTRATION with full payment due by June 6
- \$300.00 per class for registrations dropped off or postmarked **after** May 5, 2008
- All science courses require a lab fee of \$15.00 per class in addition to the class fee.

Scholarships:

- Partial tuition scholarships are available for students on free/reduced lunch. To request an application, please call Amy Wiggins at 425-837-6210. A scholarship request form must be submitted with your registration form.
- Classes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Refund Policy

- Cancellations requested on or before Monday, July 7, 2008 (day before the start of summer school) will receive a full refund
- Cancellations requested on Tuesday, July 8th will receive a refund less a \$25.00 processing fee
- Cancellations requested on Wednesday, July 9 will receive a 50% refund.
- No refunds will be issued after the second day of summer school
