

The PSAT, Preliminary SAT / National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, is scheduled for Saturday, October 20, 2007 at Liberty High School. Liberty has 180 spots available.

Juniors may register for the test starting the 1st day of school. Sophomores may register starting September 24th. Freshman will be allowed to register, on a space available basis, starting October 1st. Registrations will be accepted until Wednesday, October 17th or until all spots are taken, whichever comes first.

Cost: \$20.00 payable to the LHS book keeper. Bring your receipt to the counseling office and receive a study guide and further instructions.

Arrive at LHS: 7:50 a.m., the building will open at 8:00 a.m.

Test will be over by approximately: 11:00 am

What to bring: Calculator
#2 Pencils (at least 2, already sharpened)

Be sure to review the Study Guide (handed out to students once the \$20.00 fee is paid) to see what types of calculators are allowable and test taking strategies. Inside the Study Guide is a practice test that you may take to prepare. Additional information can be found at www.collegeboard.com/parents/tests/meet-tests/21296.html.

Food and beverages, including bottled water, are allowed *during the break only*, not during the exam. The vending machines will not be operational. You are allowed to leave the room during the exam if necessary to go to the restroom, but you will not receive additional time for testing. If you have questions, stop by the Counseling Office.
